

PUTTING CHALLENGE– 18 HOLES

RULES (MUST ADD A PENALTY STROKE)

At your golf course, on the practice green setup the distances below:

1. PUTTS THAT ARE 10 OR 20 FEET LONG YOU CAN NOT LEAVE SHORT, NOR HIT IT MORE THAN 2 FEET PAST HOLE. ADD A PENALTY STROKE IF YOU DO.
2. PUTTS 21-30 FEET, THE ERROR ZONE PAST THE HOLE IS 3 FEET.
3. PUTTS 31-40 FEET, YOU MAYBE 1 FOOT SHORT OR 3 FEET PAST.
4. PUTTS 41-50 FEET, YOU MAYBE 2 FEET SHORT OR 3 FEET PAST.

ADD A PENALTY STROKE TO YOUR SCORE IF YOUR PUTT IS NOT WITHIN THE ERROR ZONES FOR THAT DISTANCE PUTT.

18 HOLE COURSE-

PLAY 6 holes between 10-20 feet, 6 holes between 21-30 feet, and 6 holes between 31-50 feet. KEEP SCORE. SEE IF YOU CAN SHOOT EVEN PAR!!

PUTTING TEAM CHALLENGE

PRACTICE PRESSURE PUTTING WITH YOUR FOURSOME

START AT 3 FEET AWAY FROM HOLE 4 PLAYERS PER TEAM POSITIONED AROUND A HOLE, ALL PLAYERS MUST MAKE PUTT TO MOVE TO NEXT DISTANCE (+1 GRIP LENGTH). IF A PLAYER MISSES THE PUTT ALL PLAYERS MOVE TO CLOCKWISE TO ANOTHER SPOT, THE PERSON THAT MISSED THE PUTT HAS TO PUTT LAST ON THAT ROTATION. THIS DRILL IS USED BY ASU GIRLS GOLF TEAM. SEE HOW MANY FEET OUT THE TEAM CAN GET.
